





«Jean Sibelius is one of those composers who express the character of the Finnish people by their music truthfully and effortlessly», wrote the critic K. Flodin about the remarkable Finnish composer in 1891. The creativity of Sibelius is not only a bright page in the history of the music culture of Finland, but his popularity as a composer has reached far beyond his native land. His most prosperous creative period was between the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century —


a time of growing national liberation and revolutionary movements in Finland. At the time, the small state was a part of the Russian Empire and tested by the moods of an epoch of

social changes preceding a storm. It is remarkable that in Finland, as well as in Russia, this period created a significant rise in the growth of nationalistic art. Sibelius composed in various genres. He wrote seven symphonies, symphonic poems, three orchestral suites, a concert for a violin with an orchestra, two string quartets, piano quintets and trios, chamber vocal and instrumental works, music and drama performances, but his greatest talent lay in symphonic music. In Finland Sibelius played and plays an important role: he is recognized as the quintessential national composer, a symbol of greatness of the country. During his lifetime Sibelius received honours rendered to few artists. There are streets, parks and an annual music festival named after him, and the music institute he studied in was renamed as the Sibelius Academy. It is because of this that the City of Turku, which houses the Sibelius Museum, is a perfect place to organize this international competition of choruses, instrumental music and academic vocal.

Chenxiao Ran Wuhan City, China



In 2020, the Second Composition Workshop of Shanghai Public Music Academy, the chamber work 'Memorial' will be conducted and performed by Gao Jian. He has received several scholarships during his studies and has been awarded the Outstanding Graduation in the Class of 2021. He has participated in masterclasses with composers such as Aaron Jay Kernis, Lampson, and Ruoh.



Shi Zhixuan Shanghai, China

Shi Zhixuan, born in 1998 in Nanjing, Jiangsu, is currently a doctoral candidate in composition at the Shanghai Conservatory of Music, studying under Professor Zhou Xianglin. In 2016, he was admitted to the Shanghai Conservatory, majoring in both Composition and Music Design, under the guidance of Professor Lü Huang and previously mentored by Associate Professor Ji Dongyong and Professor Xu Jiangiang. In 2021, he was recommended for direct admission to the master's program in Composition as the top candidate in his field, and in 2023, he was admitted to the combined master's and doctoral track. Shi's compositions have garnered awards in numerous national and international competitions, including the Ninth Baichuan International Composition Competition, the Third and Sixth Shanghai Conservatory of Music Academy Awards, the "Futian Cup" International Accordion Composition Competition, and the Fourteenth "Ancient Strings, New Melodies" International Competition for Multiple String Instruments. His works were also selected for the Tenth China Symphony Season and the First Chinese Young Composers' Exhibition. He has collaborated with ensembles such as the Birmingham Contemporary Music Group (BCMG), Guiyang Symphony Orchestra, Shanghai Philharmonic Orchestra, Suzhou Symphony Orchestra, Emerald Zheng Ensemble, and Song of the Earth Chamber Ensemble. Additionally, he has participated in masterclasses with renowned international composers, including Aaron Jay Kernis, Tristan Murail, and Ruo Huang. Dedicated to diverse forms of artistic creation, Shi's works span a variety of genres and have been performed across China, including art songs, choral works, a cappella, chamber music, electronic music, orchestral works (both Western and Chinese), and film scores. As a composer and sound designer, he contributed to director Zehao Li's animated shorts *Sea Horse* and *Tunnel Walk*, which won awards at the Annecy International Animation Festival and the Dunhuang International Animation Festival.
